

Factsheet on COVID-19 Housing Supports

Rent Supplement

Rent supplement is available as a short term option if you are renting in the private rental market and have become suddenly unemployed. Rent supplement is a means-tested payment for people living in **private rented accommodation**. A registered full-time student is not eligible. Rent supplement is calculated based on the amount of rent payable on your tenancy and your income. It will be paid for as long as your circumstances require it.

Housing Assistance Payment (HAP)

HAP is designed for people with a long-term housing need. There have been no changes to the HAP scheme in light of COVID-19. If you are a HAP tenant, your rent will continue to be paid to your landlord and your differential rent collected as normal.

If you are a HAP tenant and have experienced a loss of income or employment due to COVID-19, you are encouraged to apply for the supplementary COVID-19 payment below. Once you are receiving this, you can contact your local authority to have your differential rent contribution reduced, if applicable, to reflect your current income. COVID-19 Pandemic Unemployment Payment

If you had a loss of income or employment due to the current situation, you may be eligible for the new COVID-19 Pandemic Payment. This payment is open to anyone aged between 18-66 who has lost employment due to COVID-19, including students, part-time workers and non-EEA nationals. The payment is €350 per week for the duration of the pandemic.
